A Special Vendor Development Programme for SC ST Vendors was organised by MRPL in Mangaluru on 07.03.2018 in association with MSME DI Mangaluru. More than 40 SC/ST entrepreneurs from all over Karnataka participated in the programme.

Socrates, Dy Director, MSME-DI, Mangaluru, Shri. G Nagaraj, Asst. Drirector – MSME. Mangaluru were the dignitaries who graced the occasion along with Shri. A Balaji, President MSSEWA and Senior officers from MRPL.

The Programme started in the morning with the MRPL theme song. Thereafter all the dignitaries joined hands to light the lamp. Shri. Praveen Pinto, Manager (Materials) delivered the welcome address.
